

Three Peaks Festival

Stallholder Terms & Conditions

1. Application & Acceptance

Submission of an application does not guarantee a stallholder position at the **Three Peaks Festival**. Organisers reserve the right to accept or decline applications at their discretion to ensure a balanced and appropriate event.

2. Site Fees & Payment

All site fees must be paid in full within **14 days of invoice or approval**. Failure to make payment within this timeframe will result in the stall allocation being **relinquished and offered to another applicant**.

3. Cancellation by Stallholder

- Cancellations made **more than 14 days prior to the event** may be eligible for a refund (at the discretion of organisers, minus any processing fees).
- **No refunds will be issued within 14 days of the event**, regardless of circumstances.

4. Event Cancellation or Postponement (Organiser)

If the **Three Peaks Festival** is cancelled or postponed due to circumstances beyond the organisers' control (including but not limited to **extreme weather, safety concerns, or government directives**), stallholders will receive a **full refund of site fees**.

Organisers will not be liable for any additional costs incurred by stallholders, including but not limited to stock, travel, wages, or accommodation.

5. Weather Conditions

This is an outdoor event and will proceed in most weather conditions unless deemed unsafe. Stallholders are responsible for ensuring their stall is weatherproof, secure, and safely installed.

6. Stallholder Responsibilities

- Stallholders must supply all equipment including marquees, tables, chairs, and adequate weights for structures.
- All structures must be properly secured for safety.
- Stallholders must remain within their allocated site boundaries at all times.

7. Insurance & Compliance

Stallholders must provide **proof of Public Liability Insurance** and any **relevant permits, registrations, or compliance documents** upon request by organisers.

Food vendors must comply with **Victorian food safety regulations**, including registration with the relevant local council and use of the FoodTrader system where required.

8. Power & Utilities

Power supply is not guaranteed unless pre-booked and approved. Stallholders must ensure all electrical equipment is tested and tagged in accordance with Australian standards.

9. Waste Management

Stallholders are responsible for maintaining a clean site and must remove all waste generated by their stall. Sites must be left clean at pack-down.

10. Set-Up & Pack-Down

Stallholders must comply with allocated bump-in and bump-out times. Early pack-down is not permitted without prior approval from organisers.

11. Conduct

Stallholders are expected to behave in a professional and respectful manner. Organisers reserve the right to remove any stallholder who fails to comply with directions or event standards, without refund.

12. Agreement

By submitting an application and/or making payment, stallholders acknowledge and agree to abide by these Terms & Conditions.
